### 47.1 DOE NI – CONSERVATION & DESIGNATIONS PROTECTION SLIEVEANORRA & CROAGHAN ASSI

The Chairman welcomed representatives from the DOE NI Conservation & Design Protection team to the meeting to update members on recently declared ASSI areas of Slieveanorra & Croaghan and to advise on their continued work on natural heritage issues. Mr McAnulty responded to questions from members including:

- 1. Rights and legal obligations of farmers and landowners to cut peat on private land in accordance with existing Turbary rights.
- 2. Rationale and method relating to the removal of heather by cutting rather than burning.
- 3. Drain maintenance and cleaning of sheughs.
- 4. Procedure for elected bodies to challenge recommendations and declarations.
- 5. Relationship of DOE with Environment & Heritage Service and Forestry Service relating to pollution issues
- 6. Method of identification of sites to be designated.

Mr McAnulty clarified the details of the Enforcement Order issued by the Northern Ireland Assembly in 2002 and the role of NIEA in contacting landowners to request permission to undertake service work. In responding to the questions asked, he outlined notifiable operations, method of consultation with farmers and landowners, the issue of consent and the policy for dealing with issues on a case-by-case basis.

The Chairman thanked the representatives for their presentation which concluded at 2.45 pm. The representatives left the meeting at this time.
