# ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES REPORT & ADDENDUM TO ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES REPORT

The Environmental Services Report and Addendum to Environmental Services Report, having been circulated were taken as read.

### **Biodiversity Update**

Copies of the Local Biodiversity Action Plan 2013-2018 were distributed on the night.

A comprehensive report was delivered by the Biodiversity Officer for Ballymoney, Coleraine, Limavady and Moyle Councils, which included a summary of projects already undertaken and future projects planned, followed by questions and answers.

Members thanked the Biodiversity Officer for her enthusiasm and her hard work in conjunction with educating schools.

Discussions included, changing of the pond in Ballymoney, nesting boxes for swifts and the possibility of plastic boxes to be available for the public to buy to build their own to encourage birds to nest, the disturbance to wildlife whilst the Pitch and Putt is being constructed in Ballycastle, the introduction of styles to improve access across The Commons, Waterfoot and the Don't' Mow Let it Grow project which encourages late cutting of verges to help maintain wildlife, insects and the flowers.

Councillor P McShane left the meeting.

### Creagagh/Craigagh Wood Local Nature Reserve (LNR)

Through the Heart of the Glens Landscape Partnership Scheme (LPS) Creagagh Wood was highlighted as a potential LNR within the Moyle District Council area. Working with the landowner, Heart of the Glens LPS, the Councils Countryside & Coast Officer and Biodiversity Officer, it is proposed that Council designate Creagagh Wood as a Local Nature Reserve.

After discussion, which included financial implications, it was agreed that Council would designate the area of land, known as Creagagh Wood as a Local Nature Reserve and Council would give approval for the Countryside & Coast Officer to progress the lease negotiations with the landowner. Details are to be brought back to Council before the lease is formally approved.

### Biodiversity Project at the Commons, Waterfoot

Reference was made to the biodiversity project at The Commons in Waterfoot, which would allow for light winter grazing to increase the biodiversity of the site, whilst improving access around the Commons through the use of styles.

After discussion, it was agreed that Council would approve the project to introduce conservation grazing to The Commons in Waterfoot, along with some access improvement works.

### Biodiversity Project - Agnew's Field, Cushendall

With reference to the Agnew's Field, Cushendall biodiversity project, after discussion, it was agreed that Council would arrange to change the cutting and bailing of the site with no fertiliser to after the end of August, to manage it as a hay meadow therefore allowing a variety of grasses and flowers to return to the site over time, and to cut a pathway through the meadow so as to encourage people to wander through.

### Welfare of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 – Authorisation of Officers

With reference to the Welfare of Animals Act Northern Ireland 2011 and in exercise of its powers under 47(A) of the Local Government Act 1972 as amended by Article 26 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (NI) Order 1985, it was agreed that Moyle District Council would appoint the under mentioned as Animal Welfare Officers:

### Approval of Premises Under EC Regulation 853/2004

After discussion, it was agreed that Council would give full approval to North Coast Smokehouse at Unit 3 Moyle Enterprise Centre, 61 Leyland Road, Ballycastle, BT54 6EZ, for the production of hot smoked fishery products following the approval of their Premises Under EC Regulation 853/2004.

### Application for Bye-Law Registration

After discussion, it was agreed that Council would approve an application for Bye-Law Registration of a business for Semi-permanent Skin-Colouring received from Joan Burns, Vanity Beauty Salon, 7 The Diamond, Ballycastle.

Councillor D McAllister left the meeting.

### <u>Presentation – Update on Technical Services Unit – Capital Works & Waste – Paul Caldwell</u>

A Technical Services Update was delivered by the Head of Technical Services, which included how the Technical Services Department operates and what it achieves, projects completed to date and those still in progress, and a breakdown of costs incurred in operating the Technical Services Department, followed by questions and answers.

Members thanked the Head of Technical Services for his detailed report. Issues discussed included Camping Cabins, rubbish thrown from cars and ferries, current work on the Tennis Pavilion, ivy growing at the Ballycastle Museum, monies spent on refuse collection and disposal, and the removal of large stones deposited by the huge storms at Ballycastle Harbour and Ballintoy Harbour.

### Tender for Refurbishment Works to Cushendall Promenade Handrail

After discussion, it was agreed that Council would appoint McLean Sandblasting Co to undertake the refurbishment works to Cushendall Promenade Handrail for the sum of £18,229.

### Tender for Vehicular Access Barriers to Caravan Parks

After discussion, which included this being operated as part of a booking system and providing access for the duration of the stay, it was agreed that Council would appoint Dallat Group to undertake the works for vehicular access barriers to Cushendun and Cushendall Caravan Parks for the sum of £18,296.

### Tender for Ballycastle Forest Entrance Improvements

After discussion, it was agreed that Council would appoint MP Coleman to undertake the works for Ballycastle Forest entry improvements (Fairhill Street) for the sum of £74,386.40.

### Update on Caravan Park Regulatory Issues (Wooden Sheds)

Reference was made to the regulatory issues surrounding the prohibition of wooden shed in Caravan Parks.

After discussion, which included Health and Safety, a meeting with Council Officers and the Cushendun Caravan Occupiers Association (CCOA) and legal advice taken, it was agreed that Council would prohibit the presence of wooden sheds on all caravan parks for the season commencing April 2015.

### Request for Permission for NIE Wayleave at Fairhill Street, Ballycastle

It was agreed that Council would approve the request from Auburn Homes, Ballymena for permission for NIE Wayleave at Fairhill Street to allow NIE to excavate and install their electric cable through Council property.

### Temporary Land Rental for Construction Compound for Ballycastle WW TW Upgrade NI Water

With reference to RPS Group requesting Council considering leasing land for a temporary construction site compound during the construction of the Ballycastle Ww TW upgrade NI Water, commencing Summer 2015, for a period of two years, it was agreed to defer this pending the outcome on discussions between NI Water and the landowner, and this then be brought back to Council.

### North West Region Waste Management Group Contractual Dispute with ReGen

After discussion,

Councillor Baird proposed, Seconded by Council Graham and resolved, "That the Meeting continued In Committee."

Reference was made to the mediation meeting which took place on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2014 to try to resolve the MDR contractual dispute between NWRWMG and ReGen. The DES summarised the situation to date for members information.
